## **Impact Your Student's Education Through the Trabuco Hills PTSA**

The Mission of the Trabuco Hills PTSA is to help cultivate an exceptional high school experience for our students and provide support for our school community.

Our goals are:

- Have a balanced approach to providing activities to Students, Teachers/Staff, and Parents that strengthen the sense of community within THHS.
- Partner with the school administration to support the educational experience of ALL THHS students.
- Be a voice for students and families on the important educational issues, with a focus on resource equity and mental health, that are important to our school community.

### **Funding**

The operating budget for all of the items PTSA funds must be replenished yearly (this equates to about \$20 per student per year). Just some of the items PTSA funds at Trabuco Hills include: College Fair, Reflections, Senior Scholarships, Parent & Student Education, Teacher Mini Grants, Staff Appreciation, Assemblies, Student Welcome Back Event, and so much more! Donations are always welcome.

### **Membership**

**This year**, you have the option to be a *Member* (\$15 [\$9.10 stays at Trabuco Hills]) or a *Friend* (\$10 [\$10 stays at Trabuco Hills]) of the Trabuco Hills PTSA. A PTSA member has the ability to vote during Trabuco Hills PTSA meetings and a portion of your fees (\$5.90) are used to support state and national education decisions and lobbying efforts. As a Friend of the PTSA, 100% of your donation will stay with Trabuco Hills and be used to directly support our students. Either way, we value your feedback and input and your financial support will ensure our ability to maintain a PTSA on our campus.
